Scholarships

Students can apply for OT Program scholarships. Financial need will be considered in addition to merit.

Students applying for a scholarship will need to provide supporting documentation regarding their financial need. This form can be completed here: OT Scholarship Form

Deadlines will be communicated by the Program based on your acceptance date.

Please be sure to upload the required supporting documents when completing this form.

Loans

OT students will also be eligible to apply for loans. U.S. citizens and permanent residents should complete the FAFSA to establish eligibility for Federal Direct Unsubsidized Loan and Federal Graduate PLUS loans.

The 2025-26 FAFSA is available to complete online at: www.studentaid.gov. Our school code is 002707.

Eligible students can borrow \$20,500 per year with the Direct Unsubsidized Direct loan, and can use the Grad PLUS Loan to cover any additional need, up to the cost of attendance. The cost of attendance includes tuition and fees, as well as estimated additional education and living expenses. If necessary, students will be able to cover all of these costs with federal loans.
